

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Board of Directors of Central Academy will accept sealed proposals for the Building Remodeling at Central Academy, including Plumbing, electrical, mechanical and HVAC portions of the project, as shown on the contracts Documents Dated June 5, 2009, until 9:00 a.m. on Monday, June 22, 2009, at the offices of Global Educational Excellence, 2455 South Industrial Highway, Suite C, Ann Arbor, MI 48014. Proposals received after that time will not be accepted. All proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud by the CAO/CFO or his representatives at the same time and place. All interested parties are invited to attend.

Plans and specifications for the project may be obtained at the offices of Global Educational Excellence at 2455 South Industrial Highway, Suite C, Ann Arbor, Michigan, between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, beginning on Monday, June 8, at 10:00 a.m. until Friday, June 19, at 3:30 p.m. All costs associated with obtaining the plans and specifications, or copies thereof, are the responsibility of the bidder. Each proposal must be accompanied by a separate acceptable bid security in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or standard form bid bond, made payable to Central Academy in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the base bid submitted. Failure of any accepted bidder to enter into contract for the work will cause forfeit of his bid security. After contracts for the work have been signed, all bid securities will be returned.

One hundred percent (100%) Performance Bond and labor and Materials Bonds are required. Costs of Bonds shall be included in Base Proposal.

**As required by State Law (P.A. 232 of 2004), all proposals/bids must be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the Owner or an employee of the bidder and any member of the Central Academy Board of Directors or the Administrators of the School. The Board will not accept a bid that does not include this sworn and notarized statement.**

Bids may be withdrawn up to the time and date of bid opening. After bid opening, bids may not be withdrawn for a period of 45 days thereafter. The Owner reserves the right to waive any irregularity or informality in bids, to reject any and/or all bids, in whole or in part, or to award any Contract to other than the low bidder, should it be deemed in his best interest to do so.
