## DESCRIPTION OF WORK

Work shall include the excavation, removal and proper off-site disposal of 2,500 tons of non-hazardous petroleum impacted soils. Work activities will also include dewatering services, placement of ORC material with backfill, and backfilling and compaction of excavated areas with clean fill materials. All project work activities to be performed in compliance with all appropriate local, state and federal regulations.
