The Davison Community Schools Board of Education is accepting bids for masonry restoration at Central Elementary School.

Sealed Bid Packages will be accepted by Daniel Romzek, Director of Finance & Operations, Davison Community Schools no later than 2:00 PM on Wednesday, April 21, 2010 at the Davison Community Schools Administration Office in the Cardinal Center, 1490 North Oak Road, Davison, Michigan 48423, opened and read publicly.

Work consists of restoration of existing masonry including all pointing, masonry unit replacement and all related work.

Individual Drawings and Specifications for each Bid Package will be available April 6, 2010 and may be obtained at the offices of THA Architects Engineers, 817 East Kearsley Street, Flint, Michigan 48503 upon deposit of \$25.00 for two (2) sets. (Refundable).

Bid security, in the amount of five (5%) percent of the total proposal, must accompany each bid in the form of a Bid Bond or Certified Check for each Bid Package. Performance and Payment Bonds will be required of the successful bidder.

Bids shall also be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the bidder or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Board of Education or Superintendent of Davison Community Schools. This disclosure shall be made on the Familial Relationship Sworn Statement form included in the Bid Package. In addition, bids shall be accompanied by a completed Bidder Qualification Form included in the bid packet. Both the Familial Relationship Sworn Statement and Bidder Qualification forms are contained in the Project Documents.

Applicable state and federal laws regarding the "Conditions of Employment" and "Prevailing Wage Rates" apply to work under this Contract apply to work under this contract, including, but not limited to the Elliott-Larsen Civil Rights Act No. 453; Public Acts of 1976 as amended.
