Bidders may obtain one (1) set of bidding documents, beginning **Tuesday, February 1, 2011**, by contacting the Construction Manager, **McCarthy & Smith, Inc.**, at (248) 427-8400. Additional plans may be ordered and purchased directly from Dunn Blue Reprographics Technology, (248) 888-5600. Bids are to be submitted in a sealed envelope supplied by the Construction Manager. The bid division being bid is to be identified on the outside of the envelope.

There will be a Pre-Bid Meeting held on **Tuesday, February 8, 2011 @ 3:00 p.m. at the North Farmington High School cafeteria located** at 32900 W. 13 Mile Road, Farmington Hills, MI 48334. The meeting **is not** mandatory, but is highly recommended. Attendees desiring to visit other schools will have the opportunity to do so after the meeting.

A **sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship** existing between the bidder and any member of the school board, school superintendents, or chief executive must accompany each bid. A board shall not accept a bid that does not include this statement. This statement is on the proposal execution form, which can be found in the Bidding Requirements and General Conditions booklet for the project, section 00400.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of five (5) percent of the amount of the bid, payable to Farmington Public Schools, as a guarantee that if the proposal is accepted, the bidder will execute the contract and file the required bonds within ten (10) days after notice of award of contract.

If awarded a contract, the successful bidder may be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price.

The Farmington Public Schools' Board of Education reserves the right to accept or reject any or all items in the bid; to accept or reject any or all bids; to waive any informalities therein; or for any reason to award the contract to other than the low bidder(s).
