Under School Code 380.1267, all bids must be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship existing between the bidder and any member of the school board, school superintendents, or chief executive. Failure to comply will result in automatic bid disqualification and non-acceptance of the bid. This statement is included as part of the Bid Proposal Form.

A Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at the Board Office, 32500 Shiawassee, Farmington, Michigan 48336 on: Monday March 23, 2009, at 1:30 p.m. Attendance is highly recommended.

Bid Proposals shall be on forms furnished by the Architect, accompanied by a satisfactory Bid Bond or Certified Check for five percent (5%) of the Base Bid Sum maximum possible proposal amount. Bidder shall agree not to withdraw Bid Proposal for a period of ninety (90) days after date for receipt of bids.

Accepted Bidder shall be required to furnish satisfactory Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

The right to reject any or all Bid Proposals, either in whole or in part, or to waive any informalities therein is reserved by the Owner.
