The Purchasing Department will make a recommendation to the Board of Education, who will either accept or reject the bids at their regularly scheduled meeting.

Qualified Bidders may obtain bidding documents from the Office of the Architect, consisting of two (2) sets of Drawings and Specifications at no charge and no deposit. Subsequent copies of the documents can be obtained from Dunn Blue Reprographics, 1009 W. Maple Rd., Clawson, MI 48017; Phone (248) 288-5600, fax (248) 288-1198, at a cost to the bidder.

Examination may be made at the Office of the Architect, TMP ARCHITECTURE, INC., 1191 West Square Lake Road, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan 48302; the MCGRAW-HILL CONSTRUCTION DODGE PLAN ROOM, Livonia, Michigan; or the CONSTRUCTION ASSOCIATION OF MICHIGAN, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan.

Return Bidding Documents to the Architect within ten (10) days after opening receipt of proposals. Documents are to be complete, in clean and usable condition and free of marks or other defacement.

Under School Code 380.1267, all bids must be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship existing between the bidder and any member of the school board, school superintendents, or chief executive. Failure to comply will result in automatic bid disqualification and non-acceptance of the bid. This statement is included as part of the Bid Proposal Form.

Bid Proposals shall be on forms furnished by the Architect, accompanied by a satisfactory Bid Bond or Certified Check for five percent (5%) of the Base Bid Sum maximum possible proposal amount. Bidder shall agree not to withdraw Bid Proposal for a period of ninety (90) days after date for receipt of bids.

Accepted Bidder shall be required to furnish satisfactory Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

The right to reject any or all Bid Proposals, either in whole or in part, or to waive any informalities therein or for any reason, to award the contract to other than the low bidder, is reserved by the Owner.
