The Hillsdale County Intermediate School District hereby solicits proposals for asphalt paving as described in the attached plans and specifications. Bids will be accepted until 11:00 A.M. on Wednesday August 19, 2009 at which time they will be publicly opened. No oral, telephonic, E-Mail, telegraphic or facsimile proposals will be accepted. No proposals will be accepted after the time of closing of bids.

The Hillsdale County Intermediate School District also known as the District reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities and irregularities in bidding. District also reserves the right to withhold bids for a period of time (60 days) from bid opening date. The District reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids in whole or in part, or to waive any informality therein. If in the District's opinion it is in his/her best interest, the contract may be awarded to other than the lowest bidder, for reason of establishing uniformity, delivery time, etc.

If award is made to us under this proposal, we agree to enter into an Agreement with Hillsdale County Intermediate School District to furnish products and/or services, in strict accordance with this proposal, bid documents and all pertinent portions of plans, drawings and specifications.

SPECIFICATIONS

- 1.0 Specifications and plans are the minimum accepted standard. Alternates will be accepted for evaluation only. The primary bid shall be as specified in these documents.
- 1.1 Hillsdale County Intermediate School District reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities therein, or to award the contract to other than the lowest bidder, which is in the best interest of the District.
- 1.2 Contractor shall submit appropriate documents of insurance (Certificates of Acord): Worker's Compensation \$100,000; Liability \$300,000; coverage pertaining to vehicles, property damage and public liabilities, personal injury, etc., and shall hold the school district harmless in any incident involving the contractor, his employees, his equipment, and vehicles.

Bidders shall visit the building area and familiarize themselves with the scope of the project.

- 1.3 The contractor shall submit a list of three (3) references complete with names, address, phone number and a contact person which will allow the District to verify ability to meet the terms of this document.
- 1.4 The contractor shall provide items of a minor nature, not specifically noted in these specifications, so as to provide a complete, operable and District acceptable installation.
- 1.5 Following award of the contract, work may commence on or after August 24, 2009
- 1.6 The contractor shall clean their job area daily and dispose of all trash and debris leaving the area broom clean. **The Districts dumpster is not to be used for contractor's trash.**
- 1.7 Contractor shall be responsible for compliance with all local, state and federal codes for the storage, handling and disposing of materials.

SCOPE OF WORK:

- 2.0 The Lochaven site will require the pulverization of approx. 15,145 square feet of existing asphalt and the preparation of sub base and aggregate base to the attached Hillsdale County Road Commission Specifications.

ASPHALT PAVING MIX AND MATERIALS:

- 3.0 The sub-base shall conform to MDOT Standard Specifications, Class II granular materials.
- 3.1 The base shall conform to MDOT Standard Specifications, dense graded aggregate 22-A.
- 3.2 Tack coat shall comply with MDOT SS-h.
- 3.3 The paving mixtures shall conform to the following MDOT specifications:
- a. Patching - MDOT #1100T, 35A
 - b. Leveling course - MDOT #1100L, 20AA
 - c. Wearing course - MDOT #1100T, 20AAA with 65% to 70% crushed material.

PREPARATION - NEW SURFACE AREAS:

- 4.0 Remove all existing materials to a depth of 9". Compact sub-grade materials thoroughly to 95% Modified Proctor using suitable compacting methods until no further movement of the soil is observed. Any area that develops weakness or cannot be consolidated by rolling shall be removed and replaced with sound material.
- 4.1 Paving shall not be placed during rainy or threatening weather or when the moisture on the surface would prevent satisfactory bonding. Do not pave when the air temperature is below 40 degrees F.
- 4.2 All old paving/surfaces abutting new pavement shall be cut to straight lines perpendicular to the new surface and tack coat applied.
- 4.3 Place a sub-base consisting of 6" of 22A limestone. Level / float until the sub-base surface is smooth and evenly distributed. Thoroughly compact to 95% Modified Proctor.

PLACING ASPHALT PAVEMENT:

- 5.0 New paving areas: Wearing course paving shall be placed in two (2) lifts of 1-3/4" each, on a properly cured tack coat to provide a finished compacted thickness of three (3-1/2) inches.

- 5.1 Compact new bituminous materials by rolling. Do not displace or extrude pavement materials from position. Hand compact areas that are not accessible to rolling equipment. All bituminous materials are to be compacted to 97% of Maximum Unit Weight determined by 50 blows Marshall Test.
- 5.2 Roll with consecutive passes to achieve even and smooth finish without roller marks. Finished surface shall be flush with existing adjacent grass / lawn area.
- 5.3 The flatness of the finished product shall have a maximum variation of 1/8" measured with a ten (10') foot straight edge. Areas that fail to conform to this standard shall be repaired at no additional cost to the District.

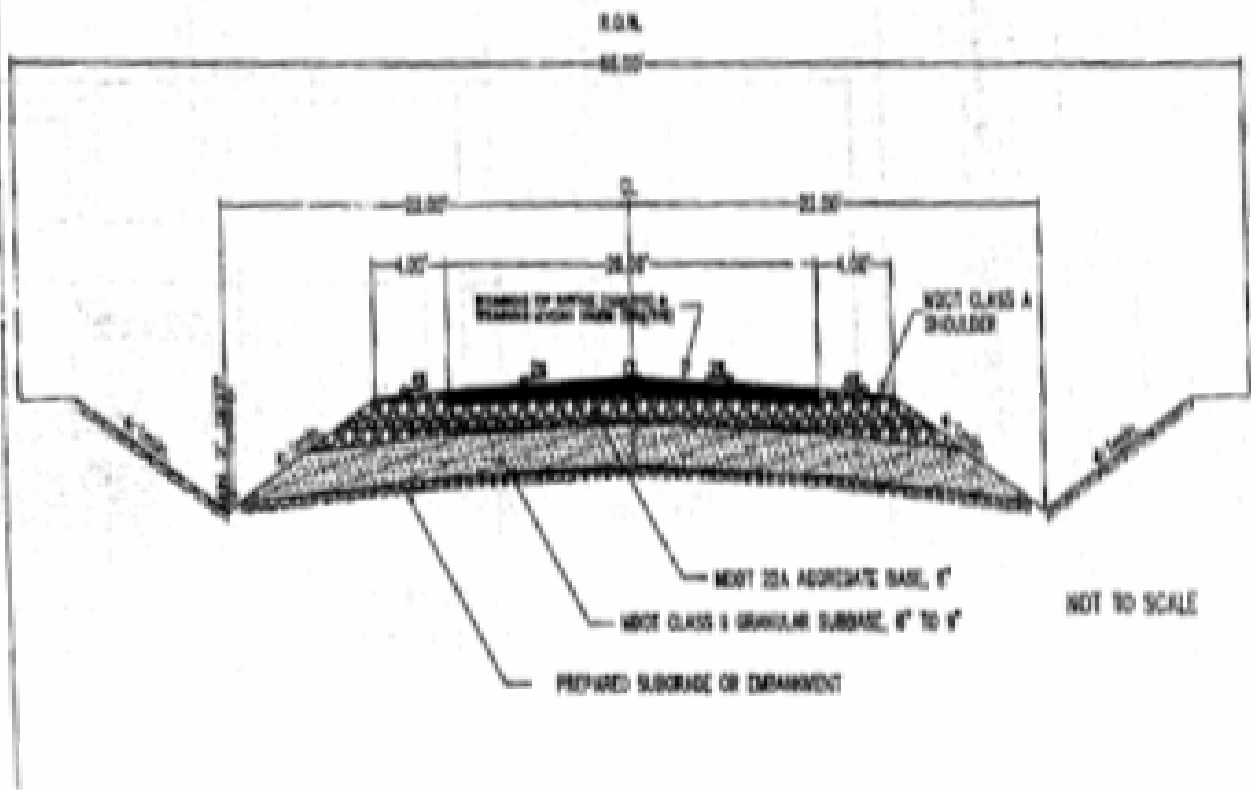

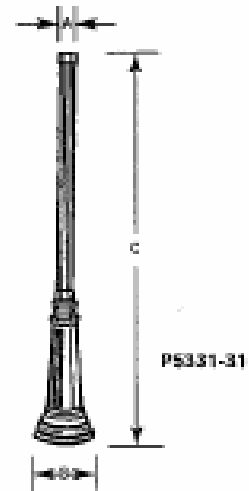
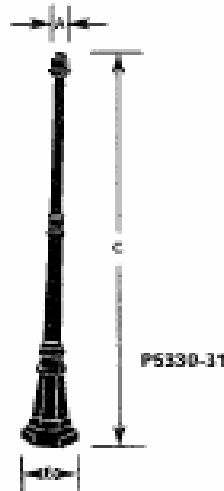
