Proposals shall be submitted in a sealed envelope or package clearly marked FF&E Proposal for Lakewood Public Schools – High School Phase II, Woodland Elementary, Sunfield Elementary, and shall be identified with the bidder's name and address.

All contractors bidding the work must be bondable and must list with their bid the cost for furnishing a Co-Obligee Labor and Material Payment Bond and a Co-Obligee Performance Bond.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashiers' check, money order, or bid bond made payable to the Owner (Lakewood Public Schools) in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the base bid as a bid security. The Owner will return the bid security of bidders under consideration immediately after award of contracts. The amount of the guarantee shall

be forfeited to the Owner if the successful bidder fails to enter into a contract and furnish required bonds and insurance within 30 days after award of contracts.

This project is subject to the State of Michigan, Department of Labor and Economic growth prevailing wage program.

All proposals submitted shall remain valid for a period of ninety (90) days after the bid date. The Owner and Architect reserve the right to waive any irregularities, reject any or all proposals, or accept any proposal, which in their opinion will serve their best interest.

Bids must include a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship existing between the bidder and any member of the School Board or school superintendent. The Board will not accept a bid that does not include this sworn and notarized disclosure statement.
