Bid Proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud by the District; however, the District will not open, consider, or accept a Bid Proposal received after the date and time specified.

All Bid Proposals shall be accompanied by a sworn statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the District or any employee of the Bidder and any member of the school board or the superintendent of the school district. The Board of Education may not accept a bid that does not include a sworn and notarized familial relationship statement.
7. Bidders are required to submit with their Bid Proposals a Bid Security of no less than 5 percent of bid amount by a qualified surety authorized to do business in the State of Michigan.
8. If awarded a contract, the successful bidder may be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price.
9. This project is to be bid and the work performed at the prevailing wage rate.
