The **Montrose Board of Education** will receive firm, sealed bids for all labor, materials, equipment, and other services to replace mechanical systems at Kuehn-Haven Middle School in accordance with the drawings and specifications prepared by ATI GROUP, 3419 Pierson Place, Flushing, Michigan 48433.

Your bid proposal, and two copies, marked “**Kuehn-Haven Middle School – Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing Renovations**” must be delivered no later than 2:00 PM, Friday, August 19, 2008, to: Lynne Clark, Financial Controller, Administration Office, Montrose Community Schools, 300 Nanita Drive, Montrose, Michigan 48457, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately thereafter. Bid proposals received after this time will not be considered or accepted.

A **mandatory pre-bid walk through** has been scheduled for **9:00 AM, Tuesday, August 5, 2008**, at **Kuehn-Haven Middle School**. Please meet in the multi-purpose room and bring all potential electrical and sheet metal subcontractors.

All bidders must provide familial disclosure in compliance with MCL 380.1267 and attach this information to the bid proposal. The bid proposal will be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Montrose Community Schools Board or the Montrose Community Schools Superintendent. The District will not accept a bid proposal that does not include this sworn and notarized disclosure statement.

The Board of Education reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, either in whole or in part; to award contract to other than the low bidder; to waive any irregularities and/or informalities; and in general to make awards in any manner deemed to be in the best interests of the owner.
