The bid opening will directly follow the close of bidding and will be held in the 2nd Floor Conference Room at the Central Administration Office.

Bids shall be executed on forms provided. Each proposal must be accompanied by a satisfactory certified check, money order or bid bond payable to Mt. Pleasant Public Schools for not less than five (5%) percent of the amount of the bid and delivered in a sealed envelope bearing the bidder's name, address and project identification.

Applicable Michigan use and sales tax apply to this project. This project requires prevailing wages.

The **High School Emergency Generator** work at Mt. Pleasant Public Schools includes removal of the existing generator, provision and installation of a new generator for emergency power and modifications to existing gas piping and electrical breakers.
