

1.1 NOTICE TO BIDDERS

- A. Newaygo Public Schools, Newaygo, Michigan, will receive proposals from qualified manufacturers for Newaygo High School Track Reconstruction, located at 200 East Street, Newaygo, Michigan 49337, which will consist of the following:
1. BP-1: Sports Field Lighting (Owner will provide sports lighting)
 2. BP-2: Excavation / Pavement Track Reconstruction
 3. BP-3: Synthetic Track Surfacing
- B. Proposals must be mailed or delivered in person to Mr. Larry Lethorn, Superintendent, 360 S. Mill Street, PO Box 820, Newaygo, MI 49337. All proposals must be sealed in envelopes, plainly labeled "High School Track Reconstruction" with appropriate Bid Package (i.e. BP-1) also noted on the envelope, and must be received prior to 2:00 P.M., local time, on Friday, May 22, 2009. This will be a public bid opening. Contractors will be notified within the allocated period of time as to their position in the bid process. Evaluation of proposals and award will be at a later date; the successful contractor will receive a letter of intent prior to receipt of contract.

- D. All bidders are required to furnish Bid Security in the amount of five (5%) percent of the Base Bid. Form of the security may be a bid bond, certified or cashiers check made payable to Newaygo Public Schools. This will be a guarantee that the bidder selected by Newaygo Public Schools will furnish the required PLM Bonds; failure to do so could mean forfeiture of the Bid Security.
- E. All bidders must indicate, where shown on the Proposal Form, the cost of Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds covering 100% of the value of the Project. Do not include the cost of the Bonds in the Base Bid.
- F. All bids shall be accompanied by a sworn statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner(s) or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Board of Education of the School District or the Superintendent of the School District. The Board of Education shall not accept a bid that does not include a sworn and notarized familial relationship disclosure statement.
- G. Applicable Michigan use and sales tax apply to this project.
- H. All bidders should note that this project does not require prevailing wages.
