Your proposal marked "**DISTRICT OFFICE RELOCATION**" will be accepted **NO LATER THAN 12:00 NOON, TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 08, 2011 TO: PINCKNEY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, 2130 EAST M—36, PINCKNEY, MI 48169-8186**. Oral, telephone, fax or electronic mail bids are invalid and will not receive consideration.

All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 12:00 p.m., Tuesday, February 08, 2011 at Pinckney Community Schools Administration Building, 2130 E. M-36 Pinckney MI 48169-8186.

A pre-bid walk through is scheduled for 4:00 p.m., Thursday, February 1, 2011 at Pinckney Community Schools Bus Garage, 2130 E. M-36 Pinckney MI 48169-8186. The pre-bid meeting will be held at the existing fueling station. **This walk through is non mandatory.**

All contracts to be entered into by the Pinckney Community Schools must and will comply with the equal opportunity laws and Davis Bacon Act.

All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid packet.

All bidders must provide familial disclosure in compliance with MCL 380.1267 and attach this information to the bid proposal. The bid proposal will be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Pinckney Community Schools, Board of Education or the Pinckney Community Schools, Superintendent. The District will not accept a bid proposal that does not include this sworn and notarized disclosure statement.

Proposals must include a Treasury listed bid bond or certified check made payable to Pinckney Community Schools for not less than five percent (5%) of the contract for each proposal over \$21,308 and must be submitted on the bid proposal form furnished with the specifications. All proposals shall remain firm for a period of sixty (60) days.

The Board of Education reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, either in whole or in part; to award contract to other than the low bidder; to waive any irregularities and/or informalities; and in general to make awards in any manner deemed to be in the best interests of the owner.
