

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Board of Directors of Riverside East Academy will accept sealed proposals for the Building Demolition and New Playground at Riverside East Academy, all as shown on the Contract Documents dated April 2, 2008, until 12:00 Noon, local time, Friday, May 2, 2008 at the offices of Riverside East Academy, 7124 Miller Road, Dearborn, MI 48126. Proposals received after that time will not be accepted. All proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud at the same time and place. All interested parties are invited to attend.

Plans and specifications for the project may be obtained from Dunn Blue Reproductions, 37660 Hills Tech Dr., Farmington Hills, Michigan beginning April 7, 2008. All costs associated with obtaining the plans and specifications are the responsibility of the bidder. Please call Dunn Blue prior to picking up plans at 248-489-1999.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a separate acceptable bid security in the form of a certified check, cashiers check or standard form bid bond, made payable to Riverside East Academy in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the base bid submitted. Failure of any accepted Bidder to enter into contract for the work will cause forfeit of his bid security. After contracts for the work have been signed, all bid securities will be returned.

100% Performance Bond and Labor and Material Bonds are required. Costs of Bonds shall be included in Base Proposal.

As required by State Law (P.A. 232 of 2004), all proposals/bids must be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the Owner or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Riverside East Academy Board or the Directors of the School. The Board will not accept a bid that does not include this sworn and notarized statement.

Bids may be withdrawn up to the time and date of bid opening. After bid opening, bids may not be withdrawn for a period of 45 days thereafter. The Owner reserves the right to waive any irregularity or informality in bids, to reject any and/or all bids, in whole or in part, or to award any Contract to other than the low bidder, should it be deemed in his best interest to do so.
