MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING: A pre-bid meeting will be conducted on March 31, 2010 at 9:00a.m. at Henry Ford II High School 11911 Clinton River Road, Sterling Heights, MI 48313.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory performance, labor and material bonds, maintenance bonds and financial statements.

Utica Community Schools reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities as deemed fit in the best interest of the school system. Proposals shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after receipt of bids.
