

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

2009 Lincoln High School Media Center Furniture & Equipment

The Van Dyke Public Schools Board of Education will receive multiple prime sealed bids (for multiple furniture categories) for the 2009 Lincoln High School Media Center Furniture & Equipment Project, on or before **Tuesday, October 13, 2009 at 10:00am**. Bids received after this date and time or bids received via facsimile will not be accepted. Bids shall be submitted to Van Dyke Public Schools, attention: Andrea Agrusa, Accounting Supervisor, which is located at 23500 MacArthur Blvd., Warren, MI 48089. Submit two (2) complete copies of bid submittal. Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud starting at 10:05am on October 13, 2009.

This project includes: Provide, installing and setup of library shelving, wood end panels and tops (for shelving), circulation desk, wood reading tables, wood chairs, task chairs, classroom chairs, lounge chairs, library security gate, distance learning console and other miscellaneous furniture for the Lincoln High School Media Center. (Bidders may bid on one item or all items listed).

Bid documents will be available on or about September 28, 2009. Contact the Architect's Office for availability. The Architect will provide up to two (2) complete bid sets for cost of \$10.00 (non-refundable) per set. Checks shall be made payable to Van Dyke Public Schools.

Make proposals on the bid form supplied in the specifications manual. No oral or telegraphic proposals or modifications will be considered. Submit with each bid, a certified check or acceptable bid bond payable to Van Dyke Public Schools, in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid. For bids in excess of \$50,000, a Labor and Material Payment Bond and a Performance Bond will be required. Due to the funding for this project, it is a prevailing wage project.

All bids shall be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner(s) or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Van Dyke Board of Education or the Superintendent of Schools. **A bid that does not include this document will not be accepted.**

Bids may not be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled time of opening bids, without the consent of the Owner. The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids received and to waive any formalities in regard thereto. In addition, the Board reserves the right to evaluate bids on any basis determined by the Board to be in the best interest of the Board and to consider alternate bids if the low bidder(s) do not meet the specifications or are otherwise determined to be unqualified.
