The Board of Education of Van Dyke Public Schools is accepting firm, sealed bids for all labor, materials, equipment and all other services to complete Asbestos Abatement at Lincoln High School and Lincoln Middle School for Van Dyke Public Schools.

A **mandatory** pre-bid walk through is scheduled for January 5, 2009 at 3:00 p.m. Meet at Lincoln High School 22900 Federal Ave. Warren, Michigan 48089. Meet in the Main Office. Your proposal marked "Asbestos Abatement Bid" will be accepted during regular business hours at the **Administrative Services Building 23500 MacArthur Blvd., Warren, MI 48089, but must be hand delivered or delivered by carrier no later than 2:00 p.m. January 14, 2009. Bid Proposals received after this time will not be considered or accepted. If mailing your proposal via the Post Office, send to same address.** Oral, telephone, fax, or electronic mail bids are invalid and will not receive consideration.

All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately thereafter at the Administrative Services Building 23500 MacArthur Blvd., Warren, Michigan 48089.

No bids may be withdrawn for at least 60 days after the bids are opened. All bids must be submitted on the forms provided in the bid packet.

All bidders must provide familial disclosure in compliance with MCL 380.1267 and attach this information to the bid proposal. The bid proposal will be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Van Dyke Public Schools Board of Education or the Superintendent of Van Dyke Public Schools. The District will not accept a bid proposal that does not include this sworn and notarized disclosure statement.

Proposals must include a bid bond or certified check made payable to Van Dyke Public Schools for not less than 5% of the contract and must be submitted on the bid proposal form furnished with the specifications. All proposals will remain firm for a period of 60 days and provide performance/labor and material bonds upon award.

The Board of Education reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, either in whole or in part, to award contract to other than the low bidder; to waive any irregularities and/or informalities; and in general to make awards in any manner deemed to be in the best interests of the owner.
