Bidders may obtain one (1) set of bidding documents, beginning **Monday, October 20, 2008, at noon** by contacting the Construction Manager, **McCarthy & Smith, Inc.** at (248) 427-8400. **Plans and specifications will also be available for pick up at the McCarthy & Smith site office located at 465 East 14th Street, Marysville, MI 48040, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** Additional plans may be ordered and purchased directly from Dunn Blue Reprographics Technology, (248) 489-1999. Bids are to be submitted in a sealed envelope supplied by the Construction Manager. The bid division(s) being bid is/are to be identified on the outside of the envelope.

All bids must be accompanied by a sworn and notarized statement disclosing any familial relationship that exists between the owner or any employee of the bidder and any member of the Board of Education or Superintendent of Schools. The Board of Education may not accept a bid that does not include a sworn and notarized familial relationship statement.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond in the amount of five (5) percent of the amount of the bid, payable to Marysville Public Schools, as a guarantee that if the proposal is accepted, the bidder will execute the contract and file the required bonds within ten (10) days after notice of award of contract.

If awarded a contract, the successful bidder may be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price. Marysville Public Schools reserves the right to reject any or all bids received, to waive any informalities and irregularities in the bidding, and to accept a bid other than the lowest bid.

This project is to be bid and the work performed at the prevailing wage rate.
