

## Under 21?

These seats **MUST** be used with the lap **AND** shoulder belt, **NEVER** the lap only.

- A booster seat holds the lap and shoulder belt in correct position.
- The lap belt should fit across the top of the thighs, not on the stomach.
- The shoulder belt should cross the shoulder, not the neck or face.

Backless Booster Seat  
If your vehicle has a high seat back you can use a backless booster seat.



High Back Booster Seat  
If your vehicle has a low seat back and your child's arms are above it, you need a high-back booster to protect his or her head.

#### Being Hard-Headed is Fashionable *Flyer*

Wearing a bike helmet can help prevent head injuries, the most common cause of death in bicycle crashes. This flyer also provides other valuable bike safety tips. (8010)

#### Buckle Up or Pay Up *Poster*

If you're not wearing your safety belt, you're going to stick out to law enforcement—much like the driver of this vehicle. (2520)



### SAFETY BELTS

#### Minor Collision, Major Body Work *Poster*

This poster provides the message that even a low-speed crash can be deadly and that motorists should always wear their safety belts. (1330)



#### Bucks *Poster*

A safety belt citation costs 65 bucks according to this poster, which uses deer heads to represent the fine. (2540)
