





Definitions, Abbreviations, and Technical Notes

Term	Definition
CEPI REP	Center for Educational Performance and Information Registry of Educational Personnel - The REP is a database that contains employment data regarding all school personnel in Michigan.
Headcount	Each individual staff member contributes a "one" to the count of school employees, regardless of FTE values. Staff members may work in multiple roles within a school system. For example, a staff member may be employed as a teacher and as an administrator, and thus would be counted once in each role. It is also possible for staff members to work for multiple schools and districts. Depending on the report, a staff member will only be counted once in each cell of the table, but could be in the "Total" cells multiple times. In the state-level charts, a staff member is only counted once.
All Staff Group Counts	This is the total of all of the staff groups; there is no additional de-duplication done. If a person is employed as a teacher and an administrator, the staff member is in the total twice - once in each group (see notes on headcount categories).
State Totals	This is the total at the state level. There is additional de-duplication done at the level of the PIC. If a person is employed in multiple districts and/or staff groups, the staff member is only counted once. (See notes on headcount categories)

Term	Definition
PIC	Personnel Identification Code. The PIC is the unique identifier for each staff member.
FTE	This is an abbreviation for full-time equivalency and is used to represent the portion of time a staff member is in each assignment. For example, if a staff member is a teacher and an administrator, they may have two assignments. One assignment may have an FTE of 0.6 and the other may have 0.4 FTE.
	This is the group to which the staff member is
Staff Group	This is the group to which the staff member is assigned, based upon the assignment code reported by the school district.
Administrators	Superintendents, assistant superintendents, principals, assistant principals, supervisors, directors, department managers, coordinators and consultants.
Teachers	Teachers include general education, career and technical education and special education teachers.
Day-to-Day Substitute Teachers	Day-to-day substitute teachers generally work for short periods of time, such as covering a classroom for a teacher's absence.
Paraprofessionals/ Aides	Teacher aides in general education, special education, migrant programs, etc.
Day-to-Day Substitute Paraprofessionals/ Aides	Day-to-day substitute paraprofessionals/aides generally work for short periods of time, such as covering a classroom or assignment when a staff member is absent for a day.
Non-instructional	All staff members assigned to non-instructional positions.
