Field Updates

As a result of the *American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009* (ARRA), data elements are required concerning technology availability within the district. Through guidance released by the U.S. Department of Education (U.S. ED) related to the ARRA, intermediate school districts (ISDs), local educational agencies (LEAs) and public school academies (PSAs) are required to submit data concerning instructional computers available to students. These data will provide the needed program performance reporting of Title II, Part D of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) as required by the Results Act.

In response to these requirements, CEPI and the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) have created three new fields that will be collected within the SID Application during the EOY 2009 SID Submission. The following three fields (pages 4, 5, and 6) should be added to the EOY 2009 SID Data Field Descriptions:

- Field 45: Instructional Computers with High-Speed Internet Access
- Field 46: Instructional Computers with Dial-Up Internet Access
- Field 47: Instructional Computers without Internet Access

The three new fields will be available in the SID Application June 1 through June 30, 2009. For those districts that utilize the SID Bulk Upload process, the new fields may be uploaded beginning June 1, 2009.

Instructions for the data submission are available in the revised EOY 2009 SID User's Guide. The user's guide is posted on the SID Web page at www.michigan.gov/cepi. Click on the "MEIS Data Services" and then click on "School Infrastructure Database." The user's guide is located under the heading SID Help.
