Record Layout

SID data will be submitted to CEPI using a comma-delimited file format. This is commonly referred to as a comma separated value (CSV) file. Please note the following items pertaining to the layout of the file:

1. Fields A, B, and C must be submitted as outlined in the EOY 2012 SID Data Field Descriptions followed by the fields in the same order as defined in the EOY 2012 SID Data Field Descriptions.
2. Each field must be separated by a comma.
3. The reserved fields must be separated by a comma and should not contain any data.
4. Completed lines should end with the value of the last field, followed by a carriage return/line feed character pair.
5. ~~Field 3 should be submitted as a character string with no separating characters between values. For example, Field 3 would be submitted like the following:~~
 - ~~000011010100010001000~~
6. For Field 4, a comma must separate each sub-field. For example, Fields 4A and 4B would be submitted like the following:
 - 3, 5,
7. A comma will always be treated as a field separator, so be sure that field values do not contain any comma characters.

Note: The following three fields are now optional for the EOY 2012 SID Submission and may be left blank. If data are reported in these fields, all programming edits will be in effect.
