As part of the necessary system maintenance, the following system reports were enhanced as follows:

- Early Childhood Special Ed Assessment List – the report was given a tune-up and now runs much faster.
- Early Childhood Special Ed Assessment Dates – a legend now displays on the last page, and a maximum of one entry assessment and one exit assessment display per student.
- Early Childhood Special Ed Program Designation – children under 3 years of age who do not have an IEP now correctly display under code 271.
- Grade or Setting with Age Data – student age now calculates correctly when running the report for prior school years.

The following business rules have been updated:

- Certification Rules – Users will no longer receive a warning for rule 100.27 for buildings that solely serve Adult Ed participants as long as at least one participant is reported with Adult Ed FTE.
- Attendance Component – Two new rules were added:
 - The number reported in the “total possible attendance” characteristic cannot exceed the number of calendar days between the student’s enrollment date (or July 1 of the current school year, whichever is later) and exit date.
 - If a student was previously reported as expected to continue, but never actually enrolled in the district, s/he can be reported with a “days attended” and “total possible attendance” of 0 if the District Exit Date is reported with a date that is one day after the Enrollment Date (e.g., an enrollment date of 4/15/15 and an exit date of 4/16/15).
- EC Programs Component – A new rule was added (171.1) to clarify that a School or Facility number must be reported when the SNE Component is submitted and the student is reported in a program other than Head Start, Early Head Start or blended Head Start. This rule replaces 171.285.3 (EC Programs Component) and 168.4 (SNE Component).
- Section 23a Component – Only claims between July and June of the current school year may be submitted in the current year SRM Collection. For example, the “month claimed” must be between July 2014 (201407) and June 2015 (201506) in the 2014-2015 SRM Collection.



Additionally, claims for the prior school year must be submitted no later than August 31 (e.g., 2014-2015 claims must be submitted by August 31, 2015).
