Four-year Graduation Cohort Status Report Definitions

The cohort status report contains longitudinal data that reflect the *most current statuses or dispositions* of high school students in relation to the "on-time" four-year graduation cohort to which they were originally assigned. Specifically, a student's cohort status may be updated based on data received in subsequent student data collections. After the final data set for a cohort's expected graduation year is received, the "on-time" four-year graduation rate will be calculated by tracking the *final dispositions* of students in their appropriate cohort.

Cohort Status Categories	Category Definitions
Dropped – Missing Expected Record (MER):	<p>a: Students who were last reported in SRSD with continuing status (19), yet were not reported in a subsequent collection.</p> <p>b: Students who were last reported as transferring to another district (exit status code 08), yet no other district reported them in a subsequent collection.</p>
Dropped – Reported:	Students who were last reported in SRSD with exit status codes categorized as "Dropped-Reported" for graduation cohort purposes (i.e., exit status codes 07, 10, 11, 13, 16, 17, and 18), and who were not reported as continuing by another district in subsequent collections.
Exempt: (formerly Transfer-Out)	<p>a: Students who were last reported in SRSD with exit status codes categorized as "Exempt" for graduation cohort purposes (i.e., exit status codes 09, 12, 14, and 15).</p> <p>b: Field 30: Student Residency (Membership) codes reported in SRSD indicate non-public or home-schooled students.</p>
Other High School Completer:	Students were last reported in SRSD with exit status codes categorized as "Other High School Completer" for graduation rate purposes (i.e., exit status codes 05, 06, 20, and 21).
Off Track – Continuing:	Students were last reported in SRSD with exit status codes of "Expected to continue in the same school district" (19), yet their expected graduation year is greater than their cohort year.
On Track – Continuing:	Students were last reported in SRSD with exit status codes of "Expected to continue in same school district" (19), and their expected graduation year is less than or equal to their cohort year.
On Track – Graduated:	Students were last reported in SRSD with exit status codes categorized as "Graduated" for graduation cohort purposes (i.e., exit status codes 01, 02, 03 and 04) and their expected graduation date is less than or equal to their cohort year.
Off Track (5 year) – Graduated:	Students were last reported in SRSD with exit status codes categorized as "Graduated" for graduation cohort purposes (i.e., exit status codes 01, 02, 03 and 04) and their expected graduation date is one year greater than their cohort year.
Off Track (> 5 year) – Graduated:	Students were last reported in SRSD with exit status codes categorized as "Graduated" for graduation cohort purposes (i.e., exit status codes 01, 02, 03 and 04) and their expected graduation date is more than one year greater than their cohort year.
Confirmed Transfers Out & Located Dropouts (information only – do not count toward rates)	Students were last reported in SRSD with exit status codes of "Enrolled in another public school district in Michigan", "Dropped out of school" or "Unknown", but have since been submitted by another school district. These students no longer count toward a district's graduation and dropout rate.

* All students in the cohort are searched for in subsequent SRSD collections, in other locations, despite their exit statuses. Only the final disposition counts towards cohort status.

Additional Definitions	
Cohort year:	<p>a: Students are placed in a cohort when they are first identified as ninth-graders or first reported in the Michigan public school system in a fall or spring collection.</p> <p>b: Ungraded students are identified as first-time ninth-graders using a computed grade (age minus 6.)</p> <p>c: Students who transfer into the public education system after ninth grade are placed in the appropriate cohort based on the grade in which the initial Michigan district places them.</p>
Last Cycle Reported:	This is the last SRSD collection in which the students were reported.
Expected Grad. Year:	This value is calculated using the cohort's standard graduation year plus the cohort's current grade minus the student's last reported grade.
Total FTE:	For each building report, this is the sum of the last reported Full-Time Equivalency (FTE) values for students in the building. Disregard for reports based on EOY collections.
Full Academic Year:	"Yes" indicates that students have been reported in the building for the two most recent consecutive count days. (e.g., for a report based on an EOY collection, the student must have been reported in the building for the previous spring and fall collections)
Total Count Days	Total Count Days in District and Building indicate the number of fall and spring collections a student was submitted in SRSD in each entity.

Formula for Estimating Potential Four-Year Graduation Rate using the number of students in each cohort status category
$\frac{\text{On-Track Graduated} + \text{On-Track Continuing}}{\text{On-Track (Graduated and Continuing)} + \text{Off-Track Continuing} + \text{Dropped (MER and Reported)} + \text{Other High School Completer}}$
