## MI Login Question and Answer Sheet

### SSO applications now migrated to MI Login

In late July, MSDS and EEM migrated from Single Sign-On (SSO) to MI Login. MI Login is the new State of Michigan Identity, Credential, and Access Management solution. The MI Login solution will provide enhanced SSO capabilities in addition to meeting many other business requirements, security, and compliance needs. ### When did the migration occur?

The migration to MI Login took place on July 26, 2016. SSO is no longer available for logging into MSDS and EEM.

### What changes occurred/are occurring?

The MI Login website can be accessed [at this link](#). If you attempt to login via SSO after the migration, you will receive a message that you are not subscribed to any applications. SSO is scheduled to be phased out completely by October 1, 2016.

### Will I need to fill out a new security form or request a new user ID?

1.) If you had an SSO account with access to EEM or MSDS prior to migration, your credentials were migrated automatically. You will need to update your contact information. You will also need to set up new security questions and answers, as those will not be migrated.

2.) If you had an SSO account with no application access, your account will need to be re-created in MI Login, as these accounts were not migrated. Please complete the security forms for the application you are requesting access to. The forms have been updated to reflect the migration, and can be found on the [CEPI Application Security Forms web page](#).
