A. Framework Activities Update

Laura Blastic, CSSTP

1. Tiger shape files were received last week, available on census.gov; moving framework delivery to April 1st to incorporate
 - a. They seem to match up quite well with our framework.
2. Working on changes from Allegan, Jackson, Kalamazoo, Marquette, Chippewa and St. Clair Counties. All changes should be incorporated prior to delivery.
3. Completing the Act 51 changes and finishing the boundary and annexation changes for 2010.
4. Boundary and Annexation changes are underway, lockdown will occur in late February

3. Cross Boundary Steering Committee met on 1/19/11. Discussed Redistricting Software, Cloud Email, Network Integration, State offered Cloud Storage Program.
