

# 2015 IMAGIN Student Poster & Paper Competition April 2, 2015

IMAGIN is proud to announce that its annual Student Poster & Paper Competition is returning for 2015. The competition is scheduled for Thursday, April 2, 2015 and will be located in Constitution Hall in Lansing, Michigan.

IMAGIN, Michigan's geospatial professional society, is accepting submissions for its 2015 Poster and Paper Competition. This competition is open to all enrolled Michigan college and university students studying or otherwise working with GIS, GNSS (GPS), and related technologies. This competition gives students the opportunity to gain professional experience, recognition, cash awards and other prizes. The top finalists from the graduate category will be invited to and recognized at the 2015 IMAGIN Conference in Traverse City, Michigan.

A couple notable changes for 2015 are:

1. IMAGIN has partnered with the State of Michigan to host the competition simultaneously with their bi-monthly GIS users group meeting
2. Graduate paper participants must present their work to be eligible for scholarships

## Undergraduate Poster Competition

Posters must focus on the application of GIS, GNSS (GPS), or related technologies. Posters must be based upon original work and completed as an undergraduate. Submittal of projects done as part of classwork is encouraged. All posters will be displayed at the 2015 IMAGIN Conference.

## Graduate Paper Competition

Papers must focus on the application of GIS, GNSS (GPS), or related technologies and must be limited to a maximum of 4000 words of text. Submittal of thesis or dissertation research is encouraged. Paper competition participants must present their work to be eligible for scholarships. Authors of the top three (3) papers will be invited to present their papers at the 2015 IMAGIN Conference.

- 1st Place for Cartographic Design: \$250

### Paper Presentation Scholarships:

- 1st Place: \$750 & Conference Registration
- 2nd Place: Conference Registration
