A. Framework Activities Update

Laura Blastic, CSSTP

1. All version 10 deliverables have been sent out. Please contact Laura Blastic or Josh Ross if you are waiting for anything. They can be reached at 517-373-7910.
2. Version 10 shapefiles have been created and will be posted to the Geographic Data Library (GDL) by July 9th.
3. We are still working on address ranges, will focus on those heavily this version.

4. Getting ready to load census block groups and tracks on this version. We are in process of writing the scripts and will begin QC later this month.

B. Digital Ortho Update

1. Bing map project QC is just about wrapped up.
2. Imagery should be here by the middle of July.
3. There may be some areas that will need to be re-flown.
4. We will work on identifying township and range that are candidates to be re-flown.
5. Microsoft did test the ingestion into Bing maps and it was successful.
6. We have flown 19 counties.
7. We are beginning to move forward for 2011.
8. NAIP 2009 processing is complete.
