SUBJECT: 7/1/06 Insurance Producer CE Suspensions

The week of 7/10/06, suspensions were processed for approximately 2,900 individual insurance producers with continuing education (CE) review dates of 2/1/06, 3/1/06, 6/1/06, and 7/1/06.

Effective for resident producers with a 2/1/06 review date or after, [2005 PA 247](#) added a required minimum of three (3) credit hours of approved ethics courses. Some individuals who were suspended met the total CE requirement of 30 credits; however, the three (3) hour ethics requirement was not met. Per Bulletin [2006-04-INS](#), notice was given that an extension was being granted to 6/1/06, which was necessarily extended to 7/1/06. No further extensions or grandfathering are being granted.

On 10/1/06, terminations for all of these affected individuals will be processed. Credits should be completed and reported to us by this date. The twelve-month reinstatement period will run from the **original** CE review date.
