• Calculation Program

Partial Benefits - The system will calculate the partial benefits that are due for each weekly period entered. The results are automatically saved in a file which can then be reopened whenever future periods need to be calculated. Reports can also be printed and attached to the Form 701 at the end of each year or whenever partial benefits are terminated.

Coordination of Benefits - The system will calculate the coordinated amount that can be offset against the weekly compensation rate. A report can also be printed and attached to the Form 701.

Third Party Recovery Offsets - The system will calculate the amount of the third party offset using the formula set forth in the *Fringes* decision. A worksheet can also be printed.

Weekly Comp Rate - The system now includes a space for discontinued fringes. The 80% rate will always be calculated based on the total of the average weekly wage and the discontinued fringes, but the general disability rate will be limited to 2/3 of the state average weekly wage, when applicable.
