**Subject:** Report on Consent Agenda

The consent agenda brings together a number of non-controversial items. These agenda items probably do not contain issues which would require the expression of minority viewpoints. Most of these items are of the nature that a consensus could be arrived at very easily.

The procedure does not allow discussion of the items. Any Board member wishing a discussion on a specific item may request that the issue be removed from the consent agenda and placed with the discussion agenda when the Board approves the consent agenda.
