Answers to West Bay Exploration Company's Petition were timely filed by Savoy Energy, L.P.; Strickler Resources, L.P.; Muskegon Development Company; and MITEP, LLC. The Answers object to the five Petitions being consolidated into one hearing and submit that Petitioner has not shown sufficient evidence in Cause No. 15-2012 that the Zmijewski Zietlow No. 1-26 well is productive of oil and/or gas from both of the two 40-acre parcels comprising the drilling unit. As owners of interests in oil and gas in, under, and that may be produced from the Zmijewski Zietlow No. 1-26 well or nearby units, the Respondents have also requested the hearing be adjourned.
