**NOTICE OF HEARING**

Take notice that a hearing will be held before the Supervisor of Wells (Supervisor) in the city of Lansing, Michigan, on the TWELTH DAY OF DECEMBER (DECEMBER 12) 2013, BEGINNING AT 1:30 P.M., AT THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY, STEPHEN NISBET HEARING ROOM, ATRIUM LEVEL, SOUTH TOWER, CONSTITUTION HALL, 525 WEST ALLEGAN STREET, LANSING, MICHIGAN. The hearing will be conducted pursuant to Part 615, Supervisor of Wells, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (NREPA), MCL 324.61501 *et seq.*; the administrative rules, 1996 AACS, 2001 MR 2, 2002 MR 23, R 324.101 *et seq.*; and the Administrative Procedures Act, 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.*; MSA 3.560(101) *et seq.*

The hearing is for the purpose of receiving testimony and evidence pertaining to the need or desirability of issuing an order in the matter of the petition of W.B. Osborn Oil & Gas Operations, LTD (Petitioner).

The Petitioner seeks an order of the Supervisor authorizing a well location less than 330 feet from the drilling unit boundary for the proposed Rhoades 2-20 Dundee Formation well, as an exception to R 324.301(1)(b)(ii). The proposed Rhoades 2-20 well will be located 145 feet from the west drilling unit boundary. The drilling unit for the Rhoades 2-20 well is the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 20, T16N, R7W, Fork Township, Mecosta County, Michigan.



Take note that if you wish to participate as a party in the hearing by presenting evidence or cross-examining witnesses, you shall prepare and mail or otherwise deliver to the Petitioner and the Supervisor, not less than five days before the hearing date, an answer to the petition in the manner set forth in R 324.1204(6). Proof of mailing or delivering the answer shall be filed with the Supervisor on or before the date of the

hearing. The answer shall state with specificity the interested person's position with regard to the petition. Failure to prepare and serve an answer in a timely manner shall preclude you from presenting evidence or cross-examining witnesses at the hearing. If an answer to the petition is not filed, the Supervisor may elect to consider the petition and enter an order without oral hearing. Mail the answer to the petition to Mr. Rex Bourland at the above address, and to the Supervisor in care of the Assistant Supervisor of Wells, Mr. Harold R.
