ADAC is a full service automotive supplier dedicated to the production of door handles and components, exterior trim, mirrors, cowl vent grilles, and marker lighting for worldwide automakers. It designs and manufactures components for Ford Motor Company (and associated holdings), General Motors Corporation, Fiat-Chrysler Automobiles, Honda Motors, Nissan Automotive, Volkswagen, Tesla Automotive and American Seating Corporation.

ADAC's locations are certified to the ISO14001:2004 EMS Standard and TS16949 Automotive Industry Quality Management Standard. Founded in Grand Rapids, Michigan in 1975, ADAC has locations in the United States, and through a global partnership with Strattec and Witte, facilities in Brazil, Mexico, and China.
