






Why burn or bury what you can recycle?

There are more living organisms
in 1 cup of soil than there are
human beings on this earth.



We make soil, not trash.

"It takes approximately 500 years to replace 25 millimeters (1 inch) of topsoil lost to erosion. The minimal soil depth for agricultural production is 6x that amount. (150 millimeters.)

From this perspective, productive fertile soil is a nonrenewable, endangered ecosystem."

"During the past 40 years nearly one-third of the world's cropland (1.5 billion hectares) has been abandoned because of soil erosion and degradation."

Contamination Issues: Glass bottles, Red bull cans, ketchup bottles, plastic, metal ramekins & silver wear


