To participate in the BlackBerry Recycling Program and download a pdf of a pre-paid mailing label, you must agree to the BlackBerry Recycling Program Agreement.

Review instructions for packaging your BlackBerry PlayBook tablet or BlackBerry smartphone

- Your package may only contain BlackBerry PlayBook tablets, BlackBerry smartphones and any peripherals or electrical accessories supplied with your BlackBerry PlayBook tablet or BlackBerry smartphone.
- If you're including a BlackBerry smartphone in your package for recycling, remove the battery and place tape over the battery ends (include the battery in the same package to be mailed).
- Don't include more than three BlackBerry smartphone batteries in a single package.

Before mailing your BlackBerry PlayBook tablet and/or BlackBerry smartphone for recycling, consider the following:

- Any information contained on your BlackBerry PlayBook tablet, BlackBerry smartphone and/or peripherals with the ability to store data will be lost. Back up, transfer, delete and/or remove any data, content, apps, media or personal, confidential or other information you wish to keep.
- Any package you send for recycling and received by the recycler won't be returned to you.

You should remove peripherals and/or electrical accessories not supplied with your BlackBerry PlayBook tablet or BlackBerry smartphone, including any peripherals that have the ability to store data, content, apps, media or any personal, confidential or other information as this information will also be lost. Peripherals and/or electrical accessories not supplied with your BlackBerry PlayBook tablet or BlackBerry smartphone should not be sent for recycling.


