

Community Recycle Rewards Event

With help from their partners, the Holland Board of Public Works was able to put on a community recycling event for appliances and e-waste. Residents were encouraged to bring in old appliances in exchange for rebates so that they were either recycled or refurbished. Additionally, 100 Freon-containing units were collected and properly recycled, ensuring that the material did not end up in a landfill. It was estimated that over 16,000 kWh of energy was saved during this single event by turning in the older, less energy efficient appliances. This event not only helped residents get rid of unwanted appliances, but also to ensure they did not end up in a landfill.
