Acer America Corporation offers two take-back programs. One is offered on the Acer America website and the other is offered on the Gateway website. Both programs are web-based mail back offerings that are free to the consumer, including shipping. A consumer wishing to trade-in or recycle old Acer, Gateway or emachines products can go online and enter their product information into the web-based tool. A postage paid mailing label will then be sent to the consumer so they can package and mail back their product. As an added bonus, the Gateway site program will pay the consumer if their product has residual value.

For customers that would rather drop-off their products at a physical location, Acer has partnered with Best Buy to support its in-store recycling program. Best Buy will accept any Acer-branded products (Acer, Gateway, and emachines) returned to their stores in Michigan and Acer will handle the cost of collection, transportation and responsible recycling, in accordance with the Michigan recycling requirements. The Best Buy program accepts all brands, however Acer only covers the cost of its own brands. The number of products allowed per day by the Acer mailback programs is unlimited. The limit on the Best Buy program is 3 devices per day.
