

Service for Customers

BenQ Takeback Program Overview

BenQ America Corp. ("BenQ") has implemented a computer monitor takeback program which provides a reasonable, convenient and available way for consumers to recycle BenQ brand computer monitors. This is a free service to consumers to return computer monitors which are end of their useful life via postage pre-paid mailing label for recycling, reuse, or refurbishing. Consumer may contact BenQ Customer Service Department at 1-866-600-2367 to request the takeback services or to obtain detailed information on the takeback program or visit <http://www.benq.us/support/recycling> for details. All BenQ brand products are affixed with permanent, readily visible BenQ brand labels.

Takeback and Recycling Steps

To recycle a used BenQ computer monitor, BenQ customers in Michigan would need to follow these steps below:

- Contact BenQ Customer Service Department at 1-866-600-2367 to obtain a postal pre-paid electronic return label from UPS via email or facsimile with packing and shipping instructions.
- Customer must supply all packaging materials which must be sturdy enough to hold and protect the material that you wish to ship. Customer must pack and ship the products in accordance with BenQ's instructions, such as weight limits, quantity, and the types of items to be recycled.
- Customer must prepare the packaged products available for drop off to the carrier identified by BenQ, provided that you are responsible for mailing the products as set forth in the instructions. Attach the prepaid shipping label to the top of the box, and deliver to the local carrier drop-off (identified by BenQ) for shipment. Products will not be returned to customer.
- Customer will make sure the material shipped is only BenQ brand computer monitor and no other products or materials. Customer also will ensure that the products shipped are the same ones customer ordered.
- Customer will ensure that the products are not contaminated or presumed of being contaminated with chemicals, biological agents or other substances that were not part of the equipment in its original condition.
- If customer fails to comply with the terms and conditions hereof, then BenQ is not obligated to offer the computer monitor takeback program to Customer.

Limitation of Liability

BenQ does not accept responsibility beyond the requirements set forth herein. BenQ will not be responsible for lost profits, loss of business or other similar, special, indirect, or punitive damages, even if informed of the possibility of such damages, or for any claim by any third party with respect to the shipment or takeback program.
