

Material is received and weighed. Each shipment is validated that it came from a covered entity and is a covered device from Michigan. Devices is sent to be de-polluted (batteries removed), the ink and toner sorted for return to manufacturer or disposal. Material removed from the devices during the de-polluting stage and are not returned to manufacturer are sent to a hazardous waste company for proper processing and disposal. Devices are then shredded and the various commodities are separated. Once separated, the commodities are put back into the commodities market for use in new products.
