This program is offered to you for any "covered electronic device" as defined by the MDEQ regardless of manufacturer of your product. We also cover all costs associated with this program including shipping of your electronic waste.

To utilize our program, please click on the link below to access our CED TakeBack form. Once you have submitted the form, an RMA will be issued along with a call tag to use when sending your unit to us for proper recycling. You will need to package your unit and drop it off anywhere UPS has pickup service - your place of business, a UPS store or other such location.

Your unwanted product will be received back at one of our manufacturing buildings to be either re-used or properly disposed of following all applicable Oregon recycling laws.


