MRM's recyclers did not collect to target this year. We believe the totals that MRM companies will report are a substantial and will be sufficient for this program year in the NON-PENALTY state of Michigan. The collection levels represent a significant increase over the first year and a good percentage of the total recycling in the state of Michigan. MRM monitored the situation closely through the year and made some changes to increase MRM pounds, such as purchasing additional weight from Dell and their collection network. We also have added additional recyclers and collection locations starting Oct. 1, 2011 so we anticipate we will meet target next year with no problem.
