Composting of Organic Wastes

- Continue discussions from last meeting

Generator/Broker/End User Obligations

- Lays out obligations under each rule
- Information that generator must give to broker or end user
- Generator certification to the department
- Label requirements that a product producer must supply to end user

Rule 110 - Other Waste Regulated by Statute

- Mineral well exemption
- Bio-solids composting exemption
- Dredging done under Part 201 or 213
- Soils generated under Part 201 or 213 left on-site
- Response activities

Rule 113 - Coal Ash Reclamation

- Rule has not been used since the rule was first written
- Can't create a facility

Rule 114 - Listed Inert Materials

- Defines what pavement is
- Inert material form must be sent prior to disposal
- Yearly representative sampling

Rule 126 - Timeframes for Approval

- Gives Department 30 days of receipt of petition to do administrative completeness review
- Gives department 60 days of administrative review to approve or deny petition

Rule 127 - Dredge Material

- Putting into rule our current process.
- Does not encompass dredge material from federal navigation projects that are disposed in confined disposal facilities or used for beach nourishment.
- Small projects not located in areas of concern are exempt from testing requirements.

Rule 129 – Uncontained Waste Piles

- Gives waste piles that existed before 1993 5 years to close
- Requires that new waste piles not be located within 200 feet of surface waters or 5 feet of groundwater
