The program covers Lenovo manufactured desktop and notebook computers and computer monitors. Lenovo has partnered with AERCCR and AERCCR's Take-Back and Regulatory Compliance management system to offer this program.

Consumers in Michigan can access the website and enter information about their location and equipment. Based on this information, a shipping label is generated, which the consumer can utilize to ship their used Lenovo product for recycling free of charge. Consumers merely pack the product and ship it using the free shipping label.
