

The recycler is R2 and OSHA 300 certified, the company maintains a system to track and manging components revmoved from CEDs. Their processing method of recycling activities are by hand dismantling, baling, and CRT glass processing procedure that comply with Federal, State, and local regulations. The recycler is an authorized recycler by Michigan Dept of Natural Resources and Environment.
