SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AREA CONSTRUCTION PERMIT

This construction permit is issued under the provisions of Part 115 Solid Waste Management of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.11501 et seq., (Part 115), to permit the construction of a solid waste disposal area (Facility) in the State of Michigan. This permit does not obviate the necessity of obtaining other clearances and permits as may be required by state law.

FACILITY DESCRIPTION: The new Type III Low Hazard Industrial Waste Landfill known as the Great Lakes Pulp & Fibre, Inc. consists of 200 acres located in the E 1/2, SE 1/4, Section 30, and the SW 1/4, Section 29, T33N, R27W, Menominee Township, Menominee County, Michigan. The facility is identified in Attachment A and is fully described in this permit.

This permit is subject to revocation by the Director of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (Director) if the Director finds that the disposal area is not being constructed or operated in accordance with the approved plans, the conditions of a permit or license, this act, or the rules promulgated under this act. This permit shall be available through the applicant during the entire effective date and remains the property of the Director. Failure to comply with the terms and provisions of this permit may result in legal action leading to civil and/or criminal penalties as stipulated in Part 115.

THIS PERMIT IS NOT TRANSFERABLE UNLESS PRIOR AUTHORIZATION HAS BEEN OBTAINED FROM THE DIRECTOR.

The permittee shall comply with all terms of this permit and the provisions of Part 115 and its rules. This permit includes the permit application and any attachments to this permit.

1. The permittee shall construct the Facility in a manner that will not violate any state or federal law.
2. This permit authorizes the construction of the disposal area as defined in the Application for Solid Waste Disposal Area Construction Permit (Application) documents, dated July 28, 1995, received by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (Department) on August 10, 1995. The new disposal area authorized by this permit shall not be utilized for the disposal of solid waste until an operating license for the disposal area is issued by the Department.
3. The attached map (Attachment A) shows the facility, the area permitted for construction, monitoring points, groundwater wells, leachate storage units, site roads, and related appurtenances.
4. Issuance of this permit is based on the assumption that the information submitted in the Application dated July 28, 1995, received by the Department on August 10, 1995, and any subsequent amendments is accurate. Any inaccuracies or deviations found in this information may be grounds for the revocation or modification of this permit and/or other enforcement action. The permittee shall inform the Department's Waste Management Division, Marquette District Supervisor, of any known inaccuracies and/or any deviation in the information of the Application which would affect the permittee's ability to comply with the applicable rules or permit conditions. This permit is issued based on Department review of the Application. The Application includes the following documents or their approved revisions which are incorporated by reference and become enforceable portions of this permit:
 - a. Application Form PR-5522
 - b. Fee in the amount of \$645.00.
 - c. Great Lakes Pulp & Fibre, Inc., Construction Permit Application, Type III Landfill, Volume I, prepared by STS Consultants, Ltd., and dated August 8, 1995, which contains: The Environmental Assessment, The Engineering Report as approved on November 7, 1995, the Operations Manual as approved on November 7, 1995, the Construction Quality Assurance Plan as approved on November 7, 1995, and the Closure and Post-Closure Plan as approved on November 7, 1995.

Great Lakes Pulp & Fibre, Inc., Construction Permit Application, Type III Landfill, Volume II, prepared by STS Consultants, Ltd., and dated August 8, 1995, which contains: appendices and supporting documentation for the Engineering Report and Environmental Assessment.

Great Lakes Pulp & Fibre, Inc., Construction Permit Application, Type III Landfill, Volume III, prepared by STS Consultants, Ltd., and dated August 8, 1995, which contains: The Hydrogeologic Study and Hydrogeologic Monitoring Plan as approved on November 8, 1995.
5. The sampling parameters and monitoring frequencies are outlined in the Hydrogeological Monitoring Plan. The sampling results shall be submitted to the Department's Waste Management Division, Marquette District Office.

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6. **VARIANCES:** The permittee is granted the following variance(s) from Part 115 and/or its rules: None.
7. **SPECIAL CONDITIONS:** The permittee may only accept paper mill waste as defined by Rule 299.4104(m) of Part 115 produced during operations by Great Lakes Pulp & Fibre, Inc., of Menominee, Michigan.
