SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AREA CONSTRUCTION PERMIT

This construction permit is issued under the provisions of Part 115, Solid Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, MCL 324.11501 et seq., to permit the construction of a solid waste disposal area (Facility) in the state of Michigan. This permit does not obviate the necessity of obtaining other authorization as may be required by state law.

FACILITY DESCRIPTION: The Dafter Sanitary Landfill, a Municipal Solid Waste Landfill, consists of 112 acres located in the W 1/2, SW 1/4, and W 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Section 33, T46N, R1W, Dafter Township, Chippewa County, Michigan. The Facility is identified in Attachment A and is fully described in this permit.

This permit is subject to revocation by the Director of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (Director) if the Director finds that the disposal area is not being constructed or operated in accordance with the approved plans, the conditions of a permit or license, Part 115, or the rules promulgated under Part 115. This permit shall be available through the applicant during its term and remains the property of the Director. Failure to comply with the terms and provisions of this permit may result in legal action leading to civil and/or criminal penalties as stipulated in Part 115.

THIS PERMIT IS NOT TRANSFERABLE UNLESS PRIOR AUTHORIZATION HAS BEEN OBTAINED FROM THE DIRECTOR.

The permittee shall comply with all terms of this permit and the provisions of Part 115 and its rules. This permit includes the permit application and any attachments to this permit.


1. The permittee shall construct the Facility in a manner that will not violate any state or federal law.
2. This permit authorizes the construction of the disposal area as defined in the Application for Permit to Construct a Solid Waste Disposal Area (Application) documents dated October 17, 2003, and received by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (Department) on October 17, 2003. The new disposal area authorized by this permit shall not be utilized for the disposal of solid waste until an operating license for the disposal area is issued by the Department.
3. The attached map (Attachment A) shows the Facility, the area permitted for construction, area(s) authorized for the placement and/or acceptance of solid waste, monitoring points, leachate storage units, site roads, and related appurtenances.
4. Issuance of this permit is based on the assumption that the information submitted by the Applicant in the Application dated October 17, 2003, revised January 15, 2004, and received by the Department on October 17, 2003, and any subsequent amendments are accurate. Any inaccuracies or deviations found in this information may be grounds for the revocation or modification of this permit and/or other enforcement action. The permittee shall inform the Department's Waste and Hazardous Materials Division, Upper Peninsula District Supervisor, of any known inaccuracies and/or any deviation in the information of the Application that would affect the permittee's ability to comply with the applicable rules or permit conditions. This permit is issued based on Department review of the Application, EQP 5506. The Application includes the following documents or their approved revisions that are incorporated by reference and become enforceable portions of this permit:
 - a. Application Form EQP 5506.
 - b. Fee in the amount of \$1,750.
 - c. Construction Permit Application, Dafter Sanitary Landfill, Volume 1: Executive Summary and Hydrogeological Investigation Report prepared by Wenck Associates, Inc., and dated October 2003.
 - d. Construction Permit Application, Dafter Sanitary Landfill, Volume 2: Landfill Environmental Assessment, Design Report and Appendices A-J, prepared by Wenck Associates, Inc., and dated October 2003.
 - e. Construction Permit Application, Dafter Sanitary Landfill, Volume 3: Design Report, Appendix K: Design Drawings prepared by Wenck Associates, Inc., and dated October 2003.
 - f. Construction Permit Application, Dafter Sanitary Landfill, Volume 4: Operations Plan and Hydrogeologic Monitoring Plan prepared by Wenck Associates, Inc., and dated October 2003.
5. The sampling parameters and monitoring frequencies are outlined in the Hydrogeological Monitoring Plan. The sampling results shall be submitted to the Department's Waste and Hazardous Materials Division, Upper Peninsula District Office.
6. **VARIANCES:** None.
7. **SPECIAL CONDITIONS:** The permittee shall exercise the Option to Purchase Real Estate for the Reid property, as described in Volume 1, Section 1, of the permit application, and close on the sale of the property before construction authorized by this permit may be initiated. The Permittee shall provide documentation verifying the sale to the Department within 60 days of exercising the option.

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
8. **TERM:** This construction permit shall expire one year after the date of issuance, unless development under the construction permit is initiated within that year.
