




Elevation of Lake Superior (Mean, 1860-1905) 602.3' above Mean Tide.



Note: Contours for 100-foot intervals are shown in continuous brown lines, and show where the lake shore would be were the island, for instance, suddenly depressed 100, 200, 300 etc., feet, respectively. The Roman numerals and heavy dotted lines indicate the stations visited in the course of the biological survey. The stations established in 1904 are marked with a prime — ' The others are located in 1905.
