

CPI WORKGROUP—SITE RECLAMATION RULES COMMITTEE

SUMMARY OF MARCH 27, 2014 CONFERENCE CALL

The Site Reclamation (Site Rec) Rules Committee met on March 27, 2014 to finalize discussions on the elimination of the Site Rec Rules. The following recommendations conclude the evaluation of the Rules:

Recommendations:

- Discussion took place regarding the need for a resolution from a Local Unit of Government (LUG) in support of a project. It was determined that although it is important to assure that the LUG supports the project, a letter of support will suffice. To that end, it is recommended that a requirement be added to 19608a(4) that states: *“the Chief Executive or Highest Ranking Elected Official provides a letter of support”*. (NOTE: This language was borrowed from EPA Application)
- The concept of discouraging development of open space and undeveloped lands was discussed extensively. The challenge came in how to best capture this concept. Following much discussion, it is recommended that this be captured by adding the following definition to Part 196: *“Eligible Property” means property that is a facility and that was used or is currently being used for commercial, industrial, public, or residential purposes.*
