

Walk to End Alzheimer's Water Stations

Pilgrim Manor and the Walk to End Alzheimer's



Pilgrim Manor was responsible for providing water for the walkers and vendors at the Walk to end Alzheimer's. Instead of providing plastic bottles of water, they opted for iced tap water in compostable/recyclable cups at three different stations both on the course and at the main event area. They estimated this reduced the environmental impact by at least 500 plastic bottles while also raising awareness. Additionally, they provided containers to separate all waste into three different streams of landfill, recycle, and compost. This reduced the contribution to landfill waste.
